#### **Route to the Trial**

Directions—Take Rt 202/31 to exit for 179. The entrance to the Fairgrounds is the second driveway to the right after the underpass, directly after the guardrail. The site is approximately 25 minutes from the Hatboro Dog Show.

### **Lure Coursing Title Requirements**

To earn the **Senior Courser (SC)** title, a dog must run at four (4) trials, with a least one other hound and get qualifying scores, under at least two different Judges or judging panels. A qualifying score is 50% of the total available points from the judges. At these same trials, if a dog also wins a placement, it can earn points towards the AKC Field Championship titles.

To earn the **Master Courser (MC)** title, a dog must complete the Senior Courser title and then earn an additional twenty-five (25) qualifying scores (with competition) in either Open, Veteran or Special stake.

To earn a **Field Champion (FC)** title, your dog must earn 15 points, including two (2) first placements worth three (3) points or more under two (2) different Judges or judging panels. Points are earned for first, second, or third place depending on the number of dogs for that breed competing. A dog that has earned its Field Championship can be entered in the Specials stake where it can compete for the Senior Courser, Master Courser or Lure Courser Excellent title

To earn the Lure Courser Excellent (LCX) title, a dog must be a Field Champion and then earn an additional forty-five (45) points. The title of Lure Courser Excellent is a cumulative title, each time the dog accrues an additional 45 championship points it would be eligible to receive the title level. (LCX II, LCX III, LCX IV, etc)

NOTE: FSS breeds are eligible for suffix titles (JC, SC, MC) only.



#### **Tests Offered**

**Junior Courser (JC):** To earn the **Junior Courser (JC)** title, "A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge on a later date stating the hound complete a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns." The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

Qualified Courser (Test): A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

Coursing Ability Test: To earn the Coursing Ability (CAT), a dog running alone must pursue a lure, completing the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a given time. Dogs that pass the CAT three times will earn a Coursing Ability (CA) title. Ten passes and a dog earns a Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) title, and 25 passes results in a Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) title.

This test is for any dog of any breed, including mixed-breeds, as long as it is at least 1 year old and individually registered or listed with AKC

# Stakes offered for the Specialty Lure Trial

*Open Stake*—Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser Title, AKC Field Champions of record may be entered. Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed twice within six trials) may not be entered.

*Specials Stake*—Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

**Veteran Stake**—Open to all greyhounds who are eligible for the Open stake and are 6 years of age or older. Championship points are awarded from this stake.

Single Stake - Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses.

After the stake winners are decided, the winners of each stake will be run in trios if possible, or braces, if necessary

The course will be reversed for the finals, run-offs and Best of Breed, or at the discretion of the judges. The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

#### **Conditions of Participation**

- Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may not be entered.
- Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the trial or Junior Courser Test.
- Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto to the test/trial grounds.
- Bitches in season, hounds with AKC breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and the entry fee refunded.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period.
- Each entry will be examined at inspection for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds without AKC breed disqualifications are eligible to participate. Monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure system will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose or interfering with the course in progress.
- A \$25.00 fine will be assessed to any owner not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.

Entries will be acknowledged. by email, if a legible email address is provided. Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted.
