### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:

**Note:** Effective for all shows held on or after July 1 1980 dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship after the Closing of Entries for this show, but whose Championships are unconfirmed may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided the transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one hour prior to the start of the judging at this show. (American Kennel Club Rule Chapter 11, Section 6)

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

**Veteran Dog Class:** A class for Dogs seven (7) to ten (10) years, and, ten (10) years and older.

**Veteran Bitch Class:** A class for Bitches seven (7) to ten (10) years, and, ten (10) years and older.

**Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at Independent Specialties. Winners to compete in Best of Variety

**BEST IN BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES:** For first place winners (all varieties) in the Bred By Exhibitor classes. **NOTE:** The person handling the dog in the class **MUST** be a breeder of record **AND** an owner of record and the dog must be individually registered at the time entries are made) For complete rules refer to Chapter 3, Section 7 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. To be judged after Best in Breed.

**COURSING CLASSES:** Non-regular classes involving single dog entries: Coursing dog and coursing bitch class for dogs and bitches who are AKC registered and are confirmed Field Champions, Coursing Champions, or Coursers of Merit. **NOTE:** Exhibitors must supply proof of eligibility for this class with the entry. A copy of the certificate awarding the title FCH, CC, CM, or a copy of the entire page from either the AKC Gazette or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof. First Place winners in this class are eligible for Best of Breed competition providing all AKC eligibility requirements have been met.

#### **AKC Grand Champion Select Competition** (*effective May 12, 2010*)

The Grand Champion Select Competition Class shall be for dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed. This includes dogs transferred to Best of Breed which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. In addition, Champions that win Non-Regular Classes & become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed Champion Veteran Class winners at independent specialties) are eligible. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed Competition.

**AKC National Owner-Handled Series:** The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers, and is conducted following the Best of Breed judging. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition. **Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog.** Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes and/or any other causes beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary. There will be no refunds for duplicate entries.

**Post Dated Checks & Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. **The GCA will assess a \$25.00 charge, in addition to all bank fees incurred, for any NSF check or any payment returned for any reason.** Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

The owner or agent assumes all responsibilities for wrong or incomplete information in the entry blanks. Entries must be made on an Official AKC entry form or photocopy of the Official AKC entry form with the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of them cannot be accepted. There are no refunds for duplicate entries. The Show Secretary will make every effort to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made. Agents may indicate their name on entry forms for inclusion in the catalog: provided they are 18 years old and neither own nor co-own the dog.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form.**

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

### SHOW SITE INFORMATION

1. Additional show site information is in the Evergreen KC Show premium available at the show.
2. The Show Site will be available to exhibitors from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, Thursday, September 7, 2017. The site will again be available at 6:00 am on Friday, September 8, 2017; Saturday September 9, 2017, & Sunday September 10, 2017 Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on September 10, 2017.
3. The grounds at this show include the show buildings, outside show grounds, and all parking areas. There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.
4. A dog wash area is available behind the Exhibition/Reserved Grooming Building and another west of the Livestock Building. All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including those in the Premium List, but not limited by them.

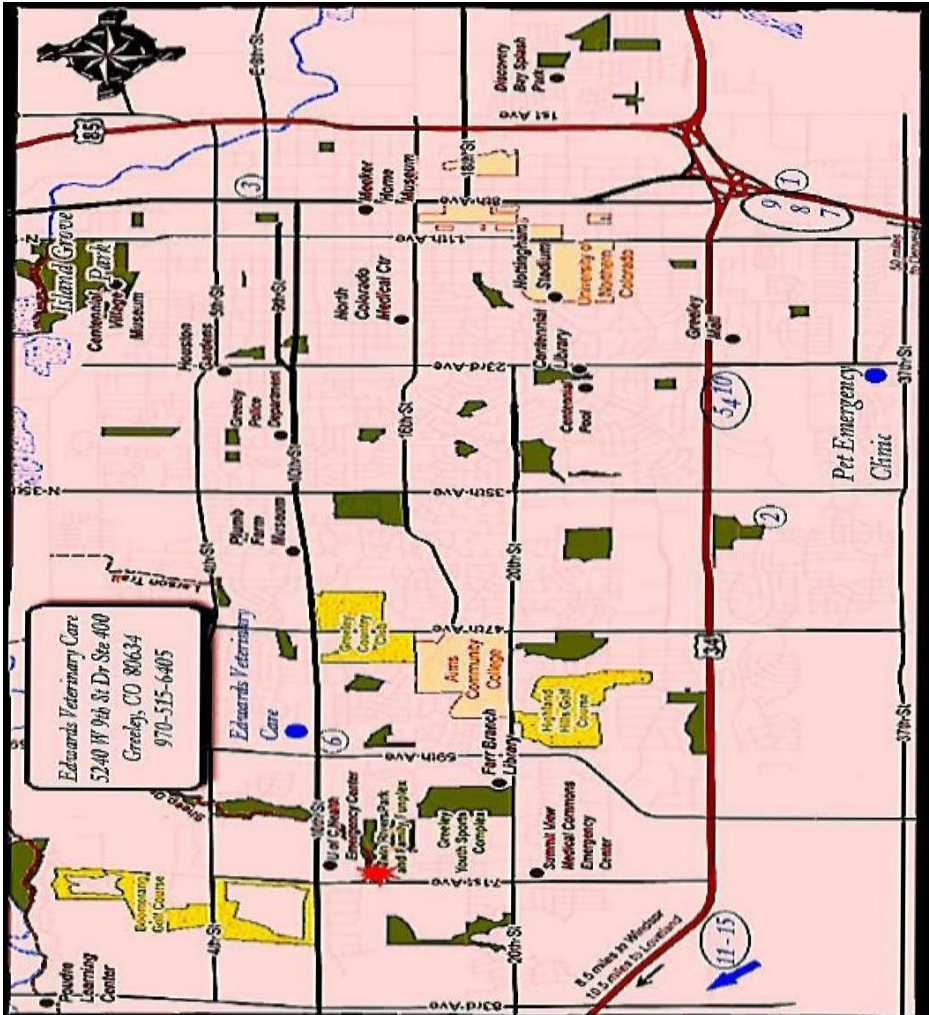
