DIRECTIONS:

From the North: Parkway or Turnpike to Rte 78W. Exit 17/Rte 31S 10 miles to Flemington Circle to Rte 202/31 S. 5 miles to Rte 179 South exit to Lambertville. Fairgrounds on right after exit ramp.

From the South: Rte 95N or 295N to 31N, 12 miles to Rte 202. You can only enter to 202N, go 1/4 mi to U-turn at Wertsville Rd. then 1/2 mile 202 South to Rte 179 South exit to Lambertville. Fairgrounds on right after exit ramp.

From the East: (Jersey Shore) Parkway to 195W to 295/95N (Loop around Trenton) to 31N, 12 miles to Rte 202. Entrance will put you on 202N, go 1/4 mi to U-turn at Wertsville Rd. then 1/2 mile 202S to Rte 179 South exit to Lambertville. Fairgrounds on right after exit ramp.

From the West: (Pennsylvania) 202N 6 miles from state border to Rte 179S/Lambertville exit. Fairgrounds on right after exit ramp.

Once in the Fairgrounds, follow the main road around behind the buildings to the field.

Eligibility

JC Test, QC Test, Lure Coursing Trial

Only purebred Greyhounds that are one year of age or older may be entered in the trial. All entries must be individually registered with the AKC, or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or has an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) from the AKC.

RIBBONS AND TROPHIES

RIBBONS:

Best of Breed: Purple and Gold Rosette.

Ribbons: First Place (Blue), Second Place (Red), Third Place (Yellow), Fourth Place (White), Fifth Place (Pink)

Each hound passing a Junior Courser or Qualified Courser Test shall be awarded a Dark Green Qualifying Ribbon.

TROPHIES:

BEST OF BREED:

Lakilanni Perpetual Trophy for Best of Breed to be awarded at the Greyhound Club of America Eastern Lure Coursing Trial, offered by Laurie Soutar. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

Leatherette Flask Kit

Highest Scoring Dual Champion—The Suntiger Challenge Trophy bronze greyhound bust offered by Gail Burnham. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

High Scoring Bench champion from any stake— The Demin Challenge Trophy, a 10” Revere bowl offered by Laurie Soutar. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

First in each Stake— Leatherette Notepad and Pen

Second through Fourth in each stake—Greyhound Notepads

Donations to the trophy fund for lure coursing would be gratefully accepted.

TESTS OFFERED:

JUNIOR COURSER TEST

Open to Sighthounds at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QUALIFIED COURSER TEST

A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed or another breed with a similar running style (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certification is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound has been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

NOTE: As of Jan 2017, an ASFA certification form may be submitted with your entry in lieu of a QC.

STAKES OFFERED: (Greyhound Trial)

OPEN STAKE: Open to all greyhounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate or ASFA certification form. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to AKC.

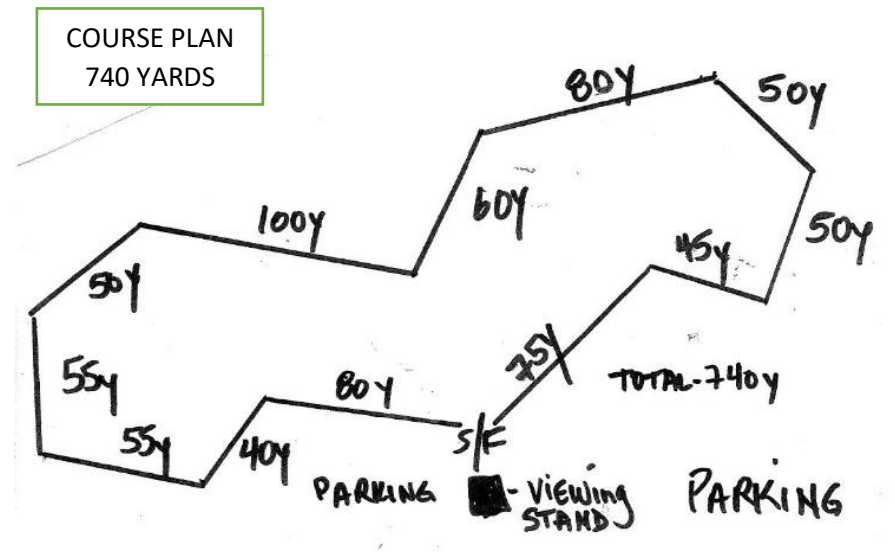
Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.

SPECIALS STAKE: Open to all greyhounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

VETERAN STAKE: Open to all greyhounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special Stakes and are 6 years of age. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship title or Lure Courser Excellent title. Qualifying scores earned from the Veterans Stake will count toward a Senior Courser or Master Courser title.

SINGLES STAKE: Open to all greyhounds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter, as are hounds that have been disqualified by a judge for being aggressive to another dog while coursing. Singles Stakes winner not eligible for BOB.

After the stake winners are all decided, the winners of each stake will be run in trios if possible, or braces, if necessary for BOB.



Conditions of Participation

- Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may not be entered, except in Singles.
- Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the trial or Junior Courser/Qualified Courser Test.
- Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto to the test/trial grounds.
- Bitches in season, hounds with AKC breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and the entry fee refunded.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period.
- Each entry will be examined at inspection for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds without AKC breed disqualifications are eligible to participate. Monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure system will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose or interfering with the course in progress.
- A \$25.00 fine will be assessed to any owner not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.

*Entries will be acknowledged by email, if a legible email address is provided.
Late, incomplete, unsigned or conditional entries will not be accepted.*
