**Eligibility**

**JC Test, QC Test, Lure Coursing Trial**

Only purebred Greyhounds that are one year of age or older may be entered in the trial. All sighthound breeds are eligible for the JC and QC tests. All entries must be individually registered with the AKC, or an AKC recognized foreign registry, or has an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) from the AKC.

**CAT Test**

The Coursing Ability Test is open to all breeds, and Canine Partners.

**Trophies**

**Best of Breed**

Best Of Breed - Lakilanni Perpetual Trophy for Best of Breed to be awarded at the Greyhound Club of America Eastern Lure Coursing Trial, offered by Laurie Soutar. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

*Best of Breed:* - Pottery Bread Tray - offered by Faith Burnham, Oquirrh Highest Scoring Dual Champion—The Suntiger Challenge Trophy bronze greyhound bust offered by Gail Burnham. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

High Scoring Bench champion from any stake— The Demin Challenge Trophy, a 10” Revere bowl offered by Laurie Soutar. For permanent possession the trophy must be won three times by the same owner but not necessarily with the same dog nor in consecutive trials.

## Tests Offered

**Junior Courser (JC):** To earn the **Junior Courser (JC)** title, "A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge on a later date stating the hound complete a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns." The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**Qualified Courser (Test):** A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

**Coursing Ability Test:** To earn the **Coursing Ability (CAT)**, a dog running alone must pursue a lure, completing the course with enthusiasm and without interruption within a given time. Dogs that pass the CAT three times will earn a Coursing Ability (CA) title. Ten passes and a dog earns a Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) title, and 25 passes results in a Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) title.

This test is for any dog of any breed, including mixed-breeds, as long as it is at least 1 year old and individually registered or listed with AKC.

## Stakes offered for the Specialty Lure Trial

**Open Stake**—Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser Title, AKC Field Champions of record may be entered. Hounds that are disqualified (or dismissed twice within six trials) may not be entered.

**Specials Stake**—Open to all hounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.

**Veteran Stake**—Open to all greyhounds who are eligible for the Open stake and are 6 years of age or older. Championship points are awarded from this stake.

**Single Stake** - Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses.

After the stake winners are decided, the winners of each stake will be run in trios if possible, or braces, if necessary

The course will be reversed for the finals, run-offs and Best of Breed, or at the discretion of the judges. The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.

## Conditions of Participation

- Hounds that are disqualified from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may not be entered.
- Hounds must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the trial or Junior Courser Test.
- Bitches known to be in season should NOT be brought onto to the test/trial grounds.
- Bitches in season, hounds with AKC breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and the entry fee refunded.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period.
- Each entry will be examined at inspection for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed and neutered hounds without AKC breed disqualifications are eligible to participate. Monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure system will be used. Backup equipment will be available. The lure will consist of white plastic strips and/or fur.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any hound loose or interfering with the course in progress.
- A \$25.00 fine will be assessed to any owner not cleaning up after their hound.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.
